Holiday Lights in Lindenwood, ND Aquatic Nuisance Species Plan

The S.S. Ruby is now 'dry docked' at Fargo's Lindenwood Park. It is outfitted with lights as part of the annual FM Sertoma Club's "Holiday Lights in Lindenwood". For an entrance fee of only \$5, an entire car load can drive through the park and see the holiday lighted displays. It is open from 5:30 p.m. - 10:30 p.m. nightly through December 31.

The North Dakota Aquatic Nuisance Species Plan is complete and open for comment. A public meeting is scheduled at 7 p.m. on Monday, December 6 at the Doublewood Inn in Fargo. The North Dakota Plan is a collaborative effort designed to prevent the introduction of aquatic nuisance species into North Dakota. The focus of the plan includes educational campaigns targeting specific audiences and monitoring of pioneering ANS infestations. The plan is open for public comment for 30 days, ending in mid-December.
