#### **Aquatic Invasive Species:**

Aquatic Invasive Species are non-native species that can harm our natural resources. To prevent the spread of these unwanted species, boaters need to:

• **Clean** visible aquatic plants, zebra mussels and other prohibited invasive species from watercraft,

trailers, and equipment before transporting from any water access.

- **Drain** water from the bilge, livewell, motor, ballast tanks, and portable bait containers before leaving water accesses or shoreline.
- **Keep** drain plug out and water-draining devices open while transporting watercraft.

Additional recommended precautions: To remove or kill hard-to-see aquatic invasive species before moving to other water bodies, spray with high-pressure , very hot water and/or dry boats and water-related equipment for at least five days.
