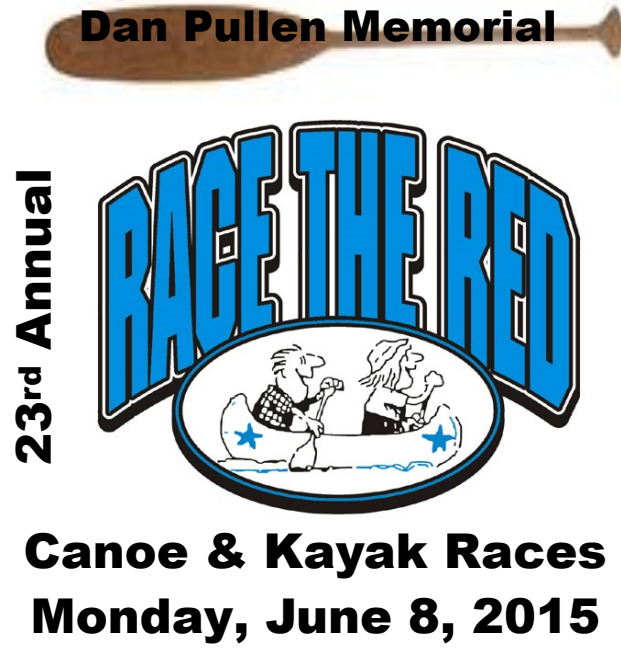

2015 Race the Red

Choose from Two Races:

Competitive Race:

Distance: 6 miles (2 miles upstream at the end)
Start time: 6:30 p.m.

Fun Race:

Distance: 3.5 miles
Start time: 7:00p.m.



The Course:

Both races begin at the River Oaks Park (100 River Oaks Point, Moorhead) and finish at Gooseberry Park's pedestrian bridge (100 22nd Ave. S., Moorhead). **This is a different course due to construction at Dike West.**

Registration:

- ♦ Entry fee is \$15/solo & \$25/team if pre-registered.
- ♦ \$10 late fee if registration not received by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 4.

Rent a Canoe or Kayak:

\$15 rental includes paddles and personal flotation devices. Limited number available.
Pre-registration encouraged.

Rules to Remember:

- ♦ Fun is the primary intention of this event!
- ♦ PFDs must be worn and fastened at all times.
- ♦ All vessels must be manually propelled.
- ♦ No tipping, bumping or splashing others.
- ♦ Alcohol is not permitted.

Aquatic Invasive Species:

Aquatic Invasive Species are non-native species that can harm our natural resources. To prevent the spread of these unwanted species, boaters need to:

- **Clean** visible aquatic plants, zebra mussels and other prohibited invasive species from watercraft, trailers, and equipment before transporting from any water access.
- **Drain** water from the bilge, livewell, motor, ballast tanks, and portable bait containers before leaving water accesses or shoreline.
- **Keep** drain plug out and water-draining devices open while transporting watercraft.

Additional recommended precautions: To remove or kill hard-to-see aquatic invasive species before moving to other water bodies, spray with high-pressure, very hot water and/or dry boats and water-related equipment for at least five days.
