- Leave the clippings on the grass as a natural fertilizer.



GRASS CLIPPING FACTS

- Dumping grass clippings into storm drains threatens water quality.
- When it rains, grass clippings, as well as the chemicals on them, get washed into the storm drains that empty into the Red River. Their decomposition harms the river.
- Decomposition causes a lack of oxygen for fish and aquatic life, thus threatening their existence.

• Grass clippings provide valuable nutrients and organic matter to your lawn, shrubs and flowers.
