

M.B. Johnson Park



M.B. Johnson Park, owned and operated by the City of Moorhead, is located on the Red River in north Moorhead, Minnesota. In 1971, 107.9 acres of land was purchased from the Martin Johnson family estate for \$107,000 to provide a regional park. M.B. Johnson Park has a varied topography, from grassy meadows to sloped wooded areas, providing multiple opportunities for activities that are primarily natural resource based.
