

Sponsors are needed for all of our events to help make them successful. Benefits and sponsorship levels vary for each event.

Annual Meeting: Previous years highlights are showcased, awards are presented, new board members are elected and a speaker presents on a river related topic.

Race the Red Canoe/Kayak Races: Participants choose from three distances (1.5, 3.5 or 6 miles) in this race for all skill levels.

Reforest the Red: Volunteers plant trees and shrubs along the Red River to maintain bank stability, encourage native plant growth, improve water quality and provide wildlife habitat.

Youth Fishing Clinics: Hands-on activity stations for youth to learn the basics about fishing from knot tying to safety to actually fishing along the Red River.

Catfish Cup: Fun best ball golf scramble for all skill levels.

Red River Water Festival: A six day event for 2100 4th grade students to participate in hands on activities to learn all about different aspects of water from history to water quality to water treatment and more.

Celebrate Our Red: Hors d'oeuvres buffet, beer and wine, silent auction, and raffle at the HoDo.

Winter Solstice Walk: Nighttime luminary walk in a riverfront park.
